We have a number of open board member positions: **Communications Coordinator, Membership Coordinator and Volunteer Coordinator**. We are also very fortunate to have seven returning board members. We have many opportunities available including smaller commitments like a willingness to lead one event or project.

Being a board member requires a minimum commitment of two hours per month to attend meetings, plus duties related to their role. While we will accept nominations up until the election, I would appreciate an indication of interest before then to make planning easier. I see the Beaumont PTA's role as providing a platform for family engagement at the school. What this means for individual families varies.
