1. Sign up for an account at www.bottledropcenters.com, collect your cans and bottles, then click the **Give link** after logging into your account to transfer your funds to **Beaumont PTA**.

Drop them off at a participating location (e.g., Hollywood Fred Meyers or Safeway on NE Sandy). These bags are tagged and directly linked to the **Beaumont PTA** account, so there is no need to set up your own account.
