BottleDrop – Did you know Oregon BottleDrop centers offer an easy way to donate your \$0.10 deposits to charitable organizations? There are two easy ways to donate:

1. Sign up for an account at www.bottledropcenters.com, collect your cans and bottles, then click the **Give link** after logging into your account to transfer your funds to **Beaumont PTA**.
2. [Contact us](#) and we'll coordinate a way to get you BottleDrop blue fundraising bags. Fill them up. Drop them off at a participating location (e.g., Hollywood Fred Meyers or Safeway on NE Sandy). These bags are tagged and directly linked to the **Beaumont PTA** account, so there is no need to set up your own account.
