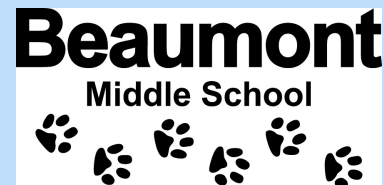

Parking Lot and Basketball Court Interruption!

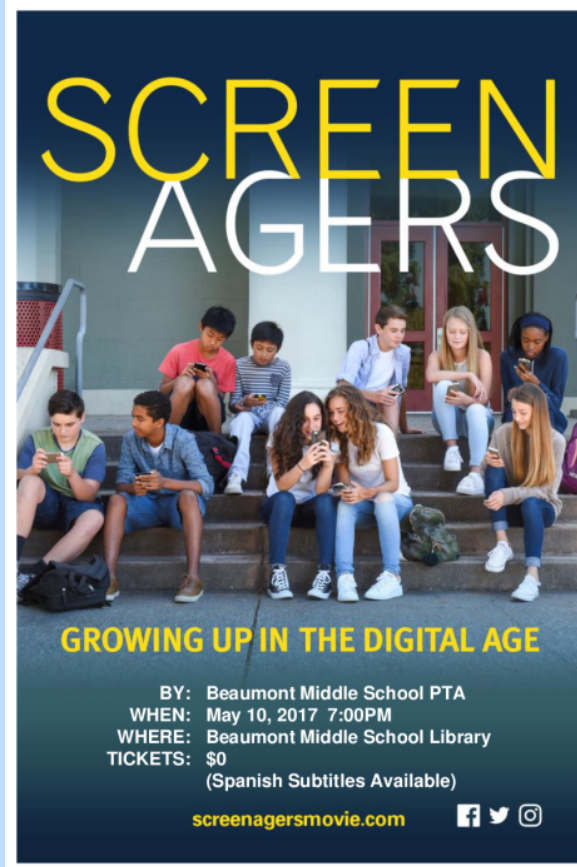

GRANT SCHOOL BASED HEALTH CENTER CLOSING

WHAT'S HAPPENING

After 27 years of providing healthcare to PPS students, the Grant School-Based Health Center (SBHC) sponsored by Multnomah County Health Department is closing on the last day of school, Thursday, June 15, 2017.

WHY IS THIS HAPPENING

The Health Department is committed to reducing health disparities and allocating resources equitably. Assessments of socioeconomic need, clinic visit data, and geographic distribution of our 13 SBHCs, indicate that other areas of the county are experiencing greater disparities and need for these limited services.

WHERE CAN STUDENTS GET HEALTH SERVICES

Grant students can still access care and services at any SBHC. Franklin will be the nearest center to the Grant-at-Marshall campus. Check out our map for more nearby locations. Additionally, students can receive health services at Multnomah County's Southeast Health Center, La Clinica and Northeast Health Center.

OUR SERVICES

- regular check-ups
- sports physicals
- care for illness and injuries
- prescription medications
- immunizations
- mental health services, including counseling
- age-appropriate reproductive health
- routine lab tests
- vision, dental, and blood pressure screenings
- health education, counseling, and wellness promotion
- referrals for services like MRIs, x-rays, and specialty care
