

 start time 9:15 AM.

Check in at Foot Traffic starting by 9:00 AM and receive your lanyard for the obstacle course. Participate in at least 90% of the obstacles and receive doughnuts hot off the press from the Pip's Mobile!

Event Details:

3K Fun Run starts at Foot Traffic Fremont and takes place on the sidewalks. 3K portion of the event ends at NE 48th and Fremont St, where the obstacle course begins. Businesses on Fremont between 48th and Foot Traffic will be hosting obstacles outside of their businesses. A list of the businesses will be listed on your lanyard, given to you at check-in. After each obstacle is achieved, the business will mark off completion on your lanyard. After completing at least 90% of the obstacles (100% completion encouraged) return to Foot Traffic for free doughnuts from the Pip's Mobile!
