

SUN School

SUN School starts next Monday Sept 19th! Still room in all clubs!

Session One Flyer is available in the Main office and the SUN office.

- We offer two session this year. Dates for 1 st Session 9/19 -12/12, Session 2 starts Jan17th to June 2. (You can expect 'new' registration forms out 2 week before the term starts)
- Yes, we charge for our programs with the exception of Study Hall which is always free.
- If you are registering for only one club, after school each week, it is only \$20. If you register for 2 or more clubs a week, a special 'multi-club' rate of \$35 is all you have to pay for the whole session. There is no limit of clubs per week. Payment is expected when you turn in the registration form.
- If budgets are an issue, scholarships are available. Please check in with the SUN Office ASAP.
- Registration is first come, first serve. Please complete the paperwork and return to the main office or to the SUN office as soon as possible.

For Students who take a bus to BMS. We still have an Extended Day bus available for you Monday and Wednesday. The bus will leave BMS at 6pm. On the Release of Information, there are three options available: Pick-Up by parent only, Extended Day Bus or Student's discretion (walk, bike, tri-met, parent). Be sure to check the box that applies to your student.
