### **PTA Clothing Volunteers Needed**

Beaumont's PTA parent organization, the Oregon PTA, runs a special Clothing Center at Marshall High. **Monday, October 31st** is Beaumont's day to send 5-6 volunteers to be a "personal shopper" to help kids receive clothing or to help sort donations to get them put out. Each school is responsible for sending volunteers on their assigned day. The **volunteer hours are 9:30am - 1:30pm** at Marshall (Franklin HS) Campus, 3905 SE 91st Avenue.

The Clothing Center has been having about 35-45 kids each volunteer day and NEEDS volunteers. One day last month they had 50+ kids come to receive clothing.
