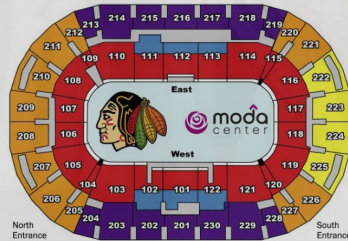

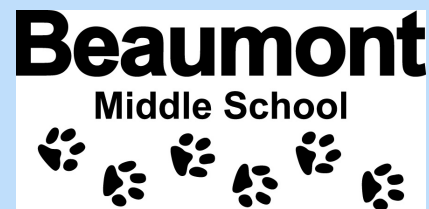

From Jennifer, RN: What are the symptoms of the flu versus the symptoms of a cold?

The [symptoms of flu](#) can include fever or feeling feverish/chills, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches and fatigue (tiredness). Cold symptoms are usually milder than the symptoms of flu. People with colds are more likely to have a runny or stuffy nose. Colds generally do not result in serious health problems.
