From Jennifer, RN:

Important tip from the nurse regarding immunization records. If you ask your doctor to print you a record from the state ALERT system, ask them to click the school report tab rather than clicking the confidential report tab. We only need page 1 of the school report tab. That report looks just like the school registration paperwork and saves you having to copy dates to the school form! Beaumont parents have been doing a good job of getting immunization records to the nurse. You can call the school office if you have questions.
