Guardian Drop Off and Pick Up Policy:

In order to ensure the safety of our students, many of whom walk/bike/skate to school, we are asking parents limit traffic on 15th.

From 8:55-9:07am and 3:45-3:57, NO CARS may enter the school parking lot. Please do not pull up and drop students in front (on 15th) during these times.

Safe places to drop off your students are on 16th or Sherett. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with our efforts to keep all Sellwood students safe.

Skateboard and Bike Policy:

We understand that many of our students come to school early to skateboard and bike with friends. If they are doing so on campus, they are REQUIRED to WEAR A HELMET.

If students are skating or biking without a helmet, they risk a \$25 ticket, issued by the City of Portland. Additionally, if students are without helmets on campus, we will call their guardian to pick up their skateboard or bike from school.

During the school day, students must stow their skateboards or hoverboards in the storage room near the main office.

Cafeteria Update:

We do not keep microwaves and hot water in our cafeteria. Please ensure your child packs a lunch that does not require heat. As usual, we will continue to offer our delicious and nutritious hot lunch!
