Lockdown Drill

Today we completed our first Lockdown Drill of the year. Two are required each year, one in September and another in March. In order to alleviate stress that students might experience during the drill, teachers discussed with students that there would be a drill, and that although there is only a small chance of ever experiencing a real Lockdown, it is still necessary to practice. The drill lasted 10 minutes from start to finish. I did not hear reports of any students upset by the drill; however, I wanted to make you aware so that you have the opportunity

to provide familial support, if needed. The prospect of gun violence is frightening for all of us, and children may need the opportunity to process with trusted adults.
