Directions for putting together the Subtraction Chart

The subtraction chart is made of 15 separate pages that need to be printed on 11 x 17 papers. You will also need two pieces of butcher paper each 55 inches long. You will need to glue/tape these vertically so that you have a finished backing that is approximately 52in x 55in. Start with the upper left piece first and then glue across the row. Each piece will overlap the previous piece so that there are no gaps in the finished chart. Once the first row is glued continue with the second row. You will be overlapping the bottom white border from the first row. Continuing this way will eliminate the need to trim each page.
