CCSB Chair Brian Caufield, Board Member Laird Cusack, and Board Secretary Jo McClain were present via Google Meet. Mr. Frank Leavitt was absent to attend another school meeting. The presiding officer of the meeting was Brian Caufield.

The meeting was called to order at 4:03 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Approval of Proposed Minutes

The Minutes of the last meeting (August 16, 2022) was approved as submitted.

2. Approval of Hiring List

Statistics provided by Mr. Leavitt for this meeting indicated a total of 35 applicants, 23 who took the test, and 19 who were interviewed. The average test score was 97.2%, the average interview score was 73%, and the overall average was 85.1%. 18 candidates were on the hiring list.

Mr. Caufield confirmed that the Board's Rule and Regulations were followed, and the list was approved.
