

Emergency Inter-District Transfer

The guidelines provided for consideration under HB 2747 and 4007 for an emergency transfer include:

- Protecting the health, safety and welfare of the student; sexual assault, threats against a student's life, or threats of imminent harm
- The student is impacted by parent or guardian's military deployment
- The student is experiencing instability related to homelessness or foster care placement
- The student has a documented medical condition that necessitates transfer
- Death of a student's parent
- The student does not have access to safe and affordable childcare in the resident district; or
- The student is involved in a documented case of severe harassment, intimidation, bullying or cyberbullying

If you feel your child may qualify for an emergency/hardship exemption, please submit a detailed letter explaining your child's circumstance to:
