#### McDaniel Highlights

Advanced Placement (AP) courses are college-level courses that are offered during high school. These courses were created by college/ university professors to reflect what is being taught in first-year college classes. This is a great opportunity to possibly earn college credit by passing the AP exam. Dual Credit courses provide the opportunity for students to earn college credit simultaneously with high school credit. McDaniel HS offers AP courses for Environmental Science, Calculus AB & BC, Spanish Literature and Culture, Spanish Language and Culture, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Human Geography, Biology, Statistics, Government, Psychology, US History, African Diaspora, African American Studies, Macroeconomics, and Seminar. By entering college with credits students may be able to graduate in less time or to take higher level courses sooner. McDaniel HS offers Advanced Placement courses and Dual Credit courses in partnership with Clackamas Community College, Oregon State University, Portland Community College, Portland State University and the University of Oregon.

McDaniel CTE program offerings include a wide range of disciplines that allow students to experience hands-on learning and acquire skills that are transferable to a multitude of future career pathways. CTE programs offer high school students cutting-edge, relevant, and rigorous classes that prepare them for post-secondary opportunities and high-wage, high-skill, and high-demand jobs. The McDaniel CTE programs include Business, Computer Science, Construction, Design & Applied Arts, Digital Design, Engineering, Future Educators, Health Sciences, and Sustainable Agriculture.
