### INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AND FAMILIES

The McKinney-Vento (formerly Title X) Homeless Program not only serves families living in shelters or cars, but all students who do not have a fixed, regular or adequate living situation.

## Who Qualifies?

- Students who are doubled up, staying with someone else temporarily due to loss of housing or economic hardship.
- Students living in motels
- Students living in emergency or transitional shelters.
- Students who are living in cars, parks, campgrounds, public spaces or substandard housing.
- Students who are unaccompanied, living without their parents or guardian.
- Migratory students who qualify as homeless because the students are living in circumstances described above.

## What are your rights?

- Enroll in school without having a permanent address or residency documents if in a qualifying living situation.
- Continue in the school that you last attended before becoming homeless if feasible.
- Receive transportation to the school you last attended. (subject to criteria)
- Enroll & attend classes while the school arranges for the transfer of immunization records or any other documents required for enrollment

*These rights were established under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act*
