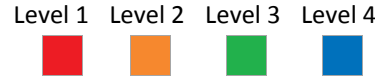

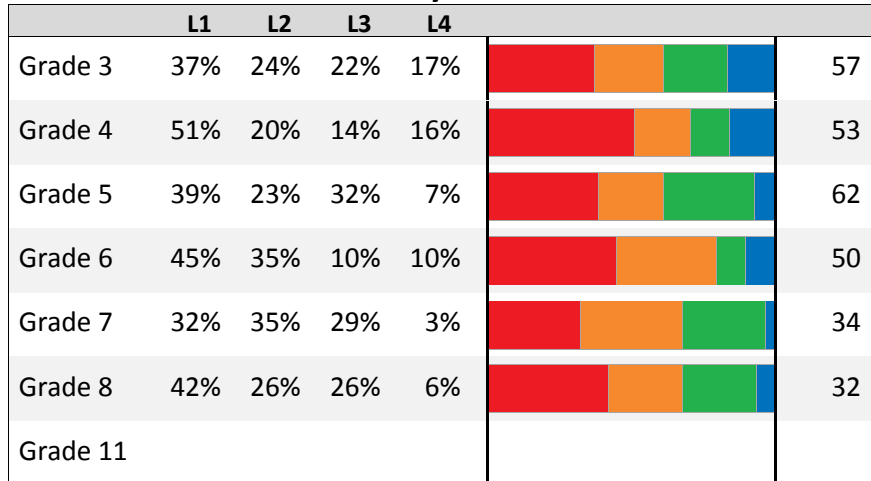

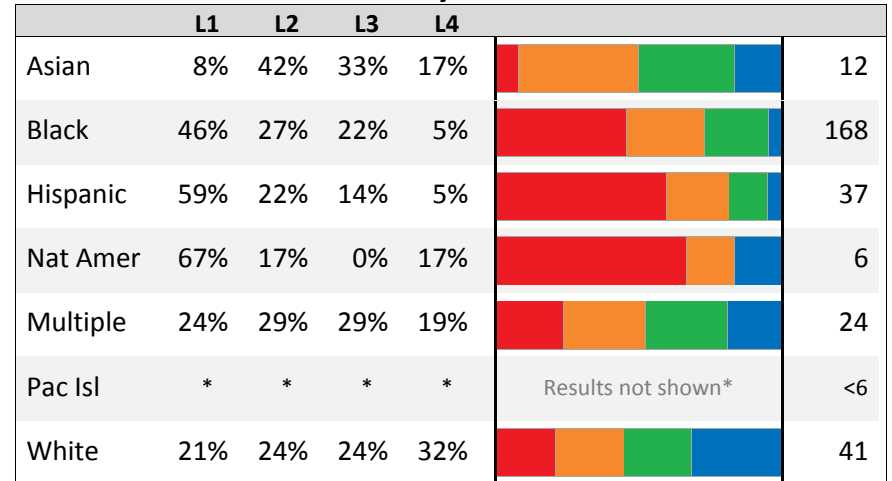
ELA Overall Achievement by Grade Level

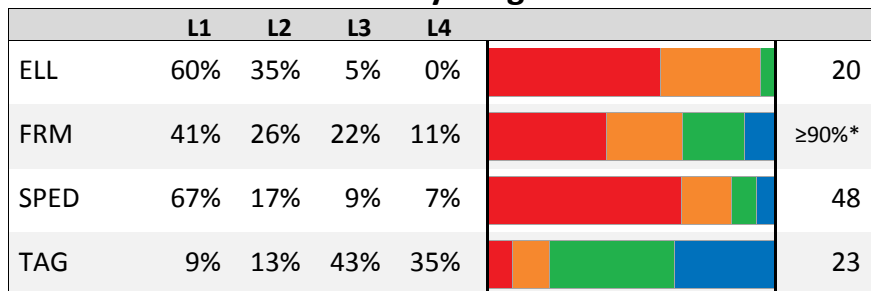
ELA Overall Achievement by Race

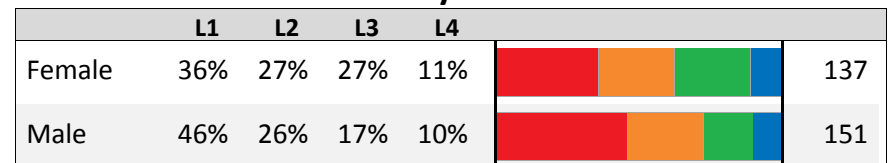
ELA Overall Achievement by Program
