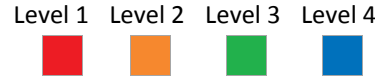

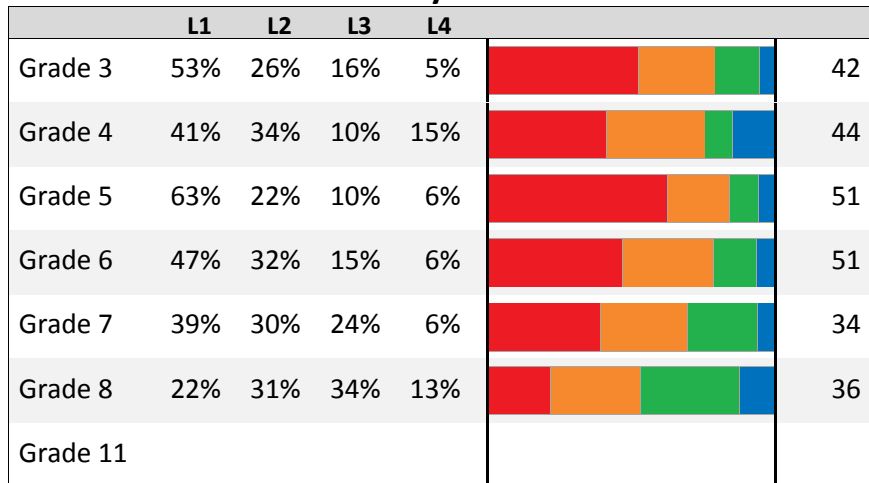

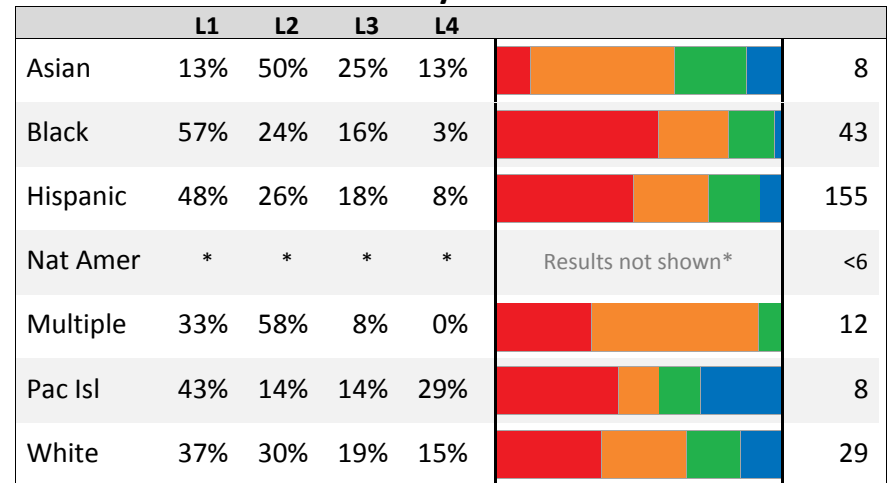
ELA Overall Achievement by Grade Level

Tested



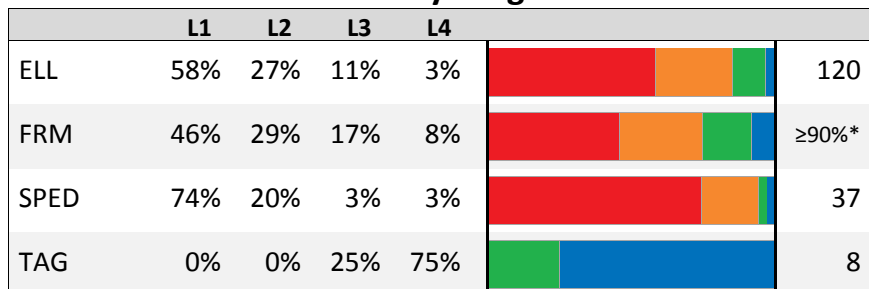
ELA Overall Achievement by Race

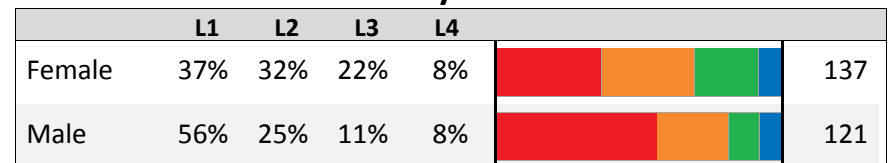
ELA Overall Achievement by Program

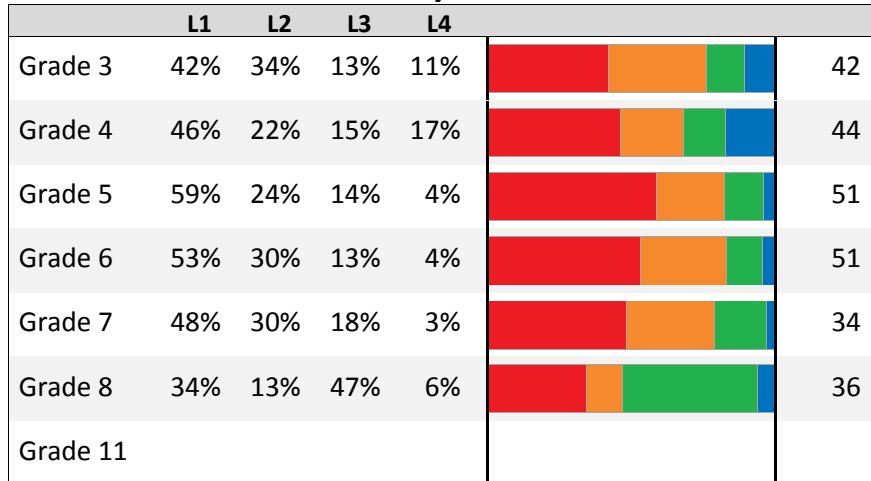

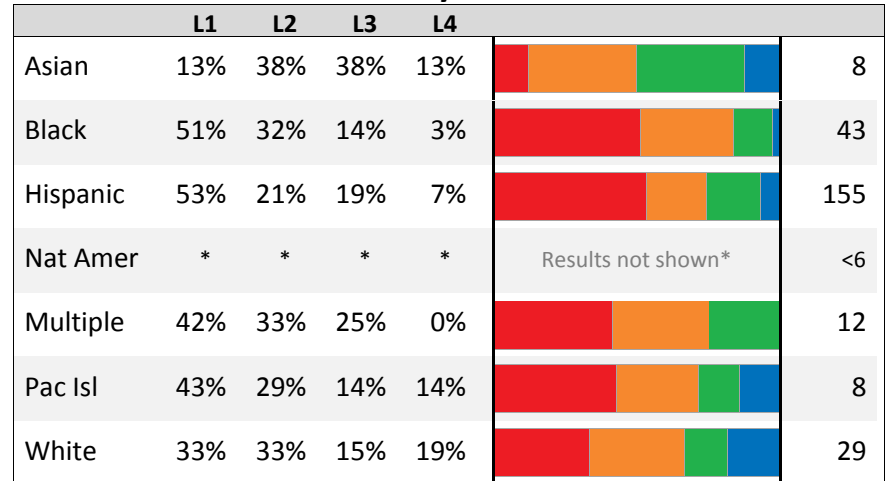
ELA Claim 1 Achievement by Grade Level

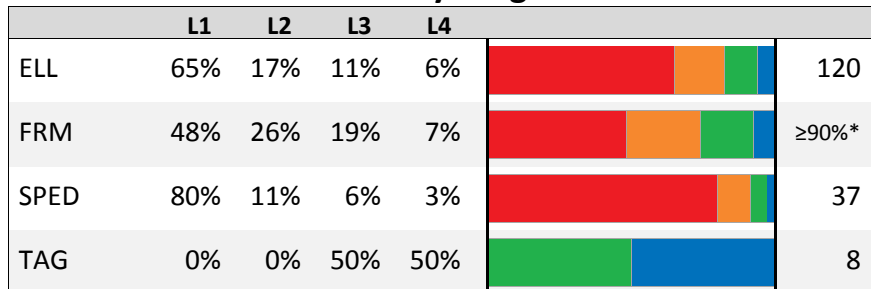
ELA Claim 1 Achievement by Race

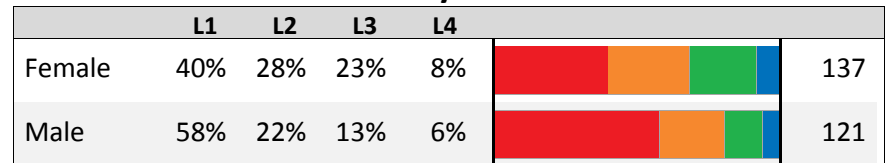



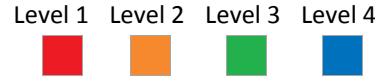
