 Teaching assistant and Study halls are not included.
 Blended grade classes are included in the median for the lowest grade (ex. if a school has a 3/4 blend, all the students would be included in the average and median for 1st-3rd grade).
 Classes with multiple teachers are only included once.
 Starting in 2019-20, PK students are excluded from all class size calculations. This makes the data more comparable across schools. Caution should be used in comparing prior year reports though.
