Non-Hispanic students with multiple race designations are counted in the Multi-Racial sub-group. Non-Hispanic students with only one race designation will be counted in that racial sub-group. Undetermined race and/or ethnicity in the current year student information system were updated with race/ethnicity in prior year student information system -- this mainly impacts the Asian / Pacific Islander subgroup, which will be separated into Asian and Hawaiian/Pacific Islander by the end of the 2009-10 School Year.
