**Notes:**

Combined Underserved counts are determined based on each school’s number of students who meet one of the following criteria: Special Education Eligibility, Limited English Proficiency, Eligibility to receive Free Meals by Direct Certification, Black, Hispanic, Native American or Pacific Islander race. These historically underserved groups are similar to the groups by which the Oregon Department of Education measures the Achievement Gap in designating schools as “Focus Schools.”

Free by Direct Certification is the number/percent of total students who receive free meals through data shared by the state with the school district. This excludes students eligible for free or reduced price meals by paper application or students eligible for free meals because they are enrolled in a CEP school but who do not meet income guidelines if they were not at a CEP school. Free Meal by Direct Certification % is comparable across all schools.

SpEd are students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) receiving special education services.

Limited English Proficient (LEP) is the count of students eligible to receive English as a Second Language (ESL) or Bilingual Services.

Historically Underserved includes students flagged as Hispanic and students flagged as only one of the following: Black, Native American or Pacific Islander.
