## Portland Public Schools October 1st, 2021 Enrollment - Summary Comparison

Enrollment Summaries are based on enrollment on October 1st as reported in the Period 1 Cumulative Average Daily Membership State Report.

School configuration changes will impact the year-to-year counts by Program Type, as 6-8 grades are moved from K-8 schools to new Middle Schools.

Students in the student information system (SIS) who are only receiving Special Education services and are not regularly attending PPS are excluded from the enrollment summaries.
