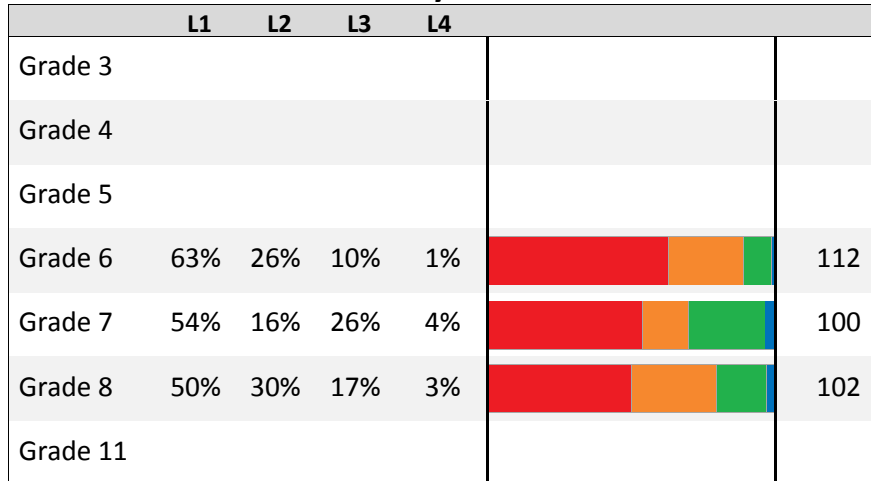

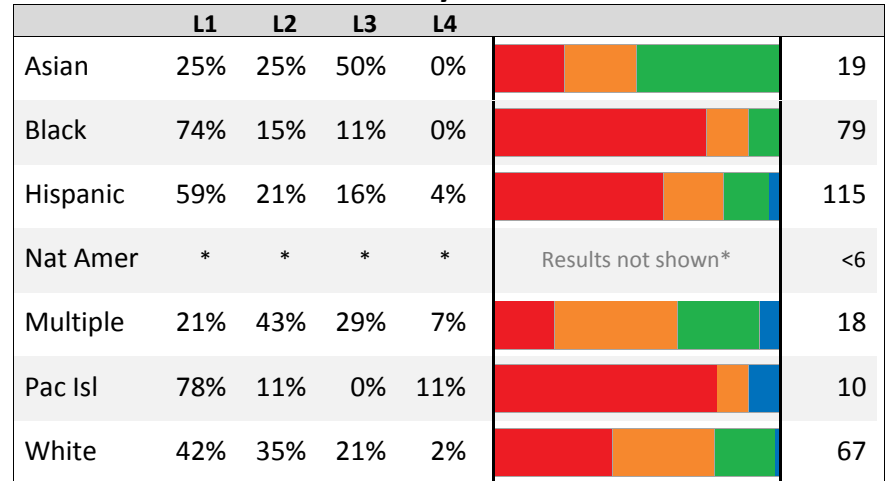
ELA Claim 2 Achievement by Grade Level

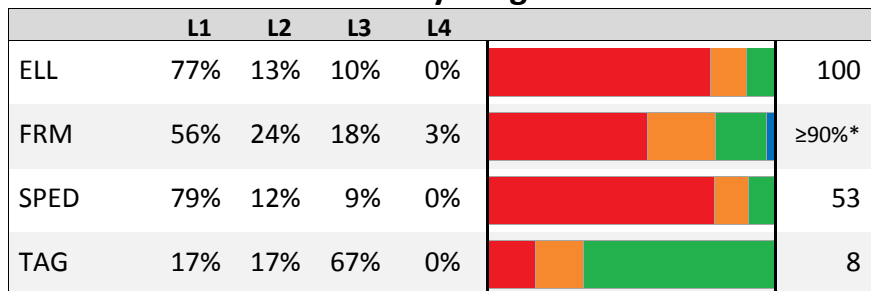
ELA Claim 2 Achievement by Race

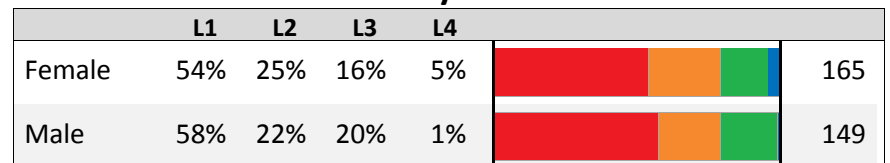
