







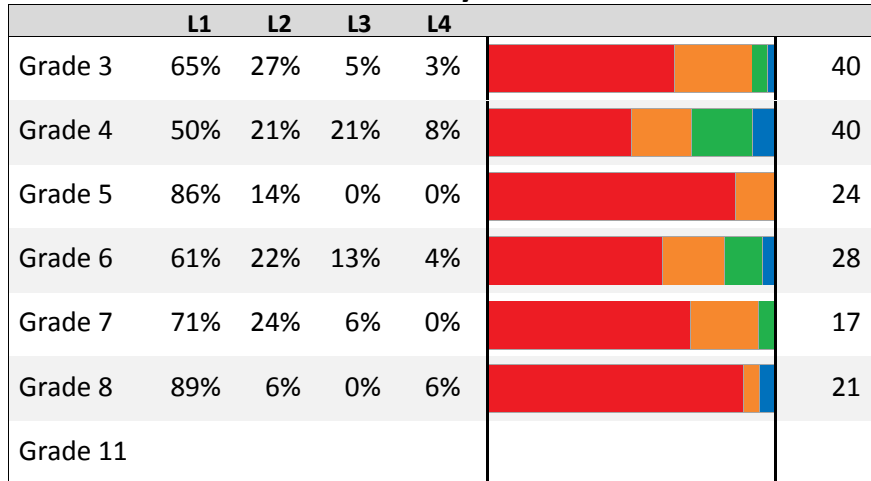

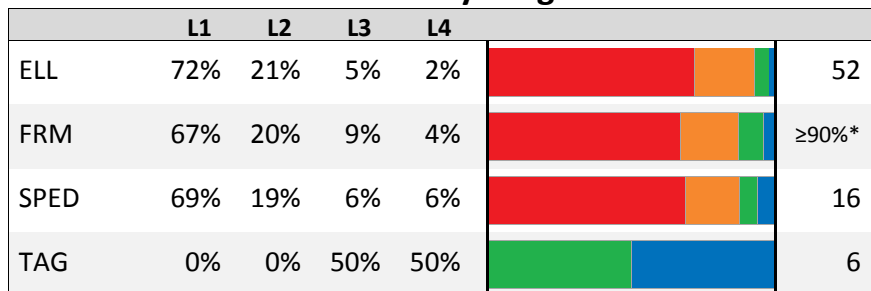
### Math Claim 3 Achievement by Grade Level # Tested



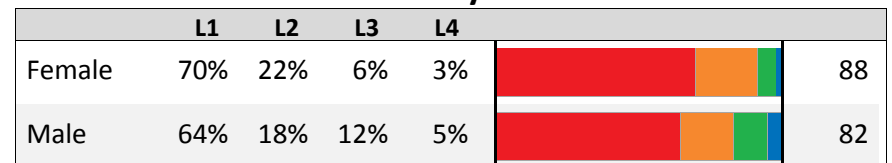
