Late Enrollee Ratio:

This is the percentage of students in a given school year who enrolled after October 3rd compared to those who enrolled by October 3rd. The formula is A / B , where:

A = the number of students first enrolled at school after October 3rd

B = the number of students enrolled on October 3rd

Stability Index:

This is the percentage of students in a given school year who were enrolled at the same school through most of the school year compared to all students enrolled on October 3rd. The formula used is A / B , where:

A = number of students enrolled in the same school through most of the school year (≥ 145 school days)

B = the number of students enrolled on October 3rd

Note: Calculation of stability changed starting in the 2004-05 school year.

Prior to 2004-05, stability was determined by if a student was enrolled on both October 1st and June 1st.

Beginning in 2004-05, stability was determined instead based on a student being enrolled at least 145 days at a school, which is approximately 85% of the school year.

The revised method better accommodates non-standard school calendars, seniors who graduate (and quit attending) in May, and 'short' breaks in educational service.

School Notes: Rosa Parks and Kairos PDX are year-round schools, so October membership may not be an appropriate denominator for their Late Enrollee Ratio
