Late Enrollee Ratio:

This is the percentage of students in a given school year who enrolled after October 1st compared to those who enrolled by October 1st. The formula is A / B, where:

A = the number of students first enrolled at school after October 1st

B = the number of students enrolled on October 1st

Stability Index:

This is the percentage of students in a given school year who were enrolled at the same school through most of the school year compared to all students enrolled on October 1st. The formula used is A / B, where:

A = number of students enrolled in the same school through most of the school year (>=145 school days)

B = the number of students enrolled on October 1st

<u>School Notes</u>: Kairos PDX is a year-round school, so October membership may not be an appropriate denominator for their Late Enrollee Ratio

Alliance and Online Learning Academy enrolled additional students throughout the year, so October membership may
