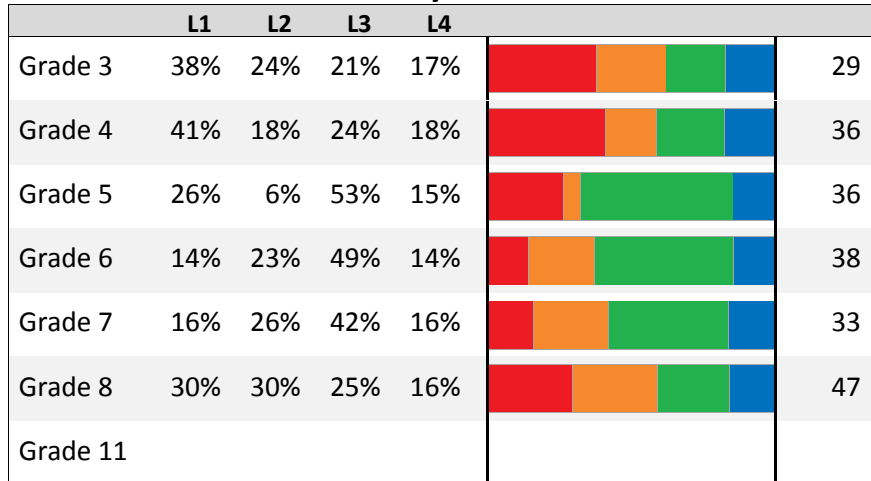

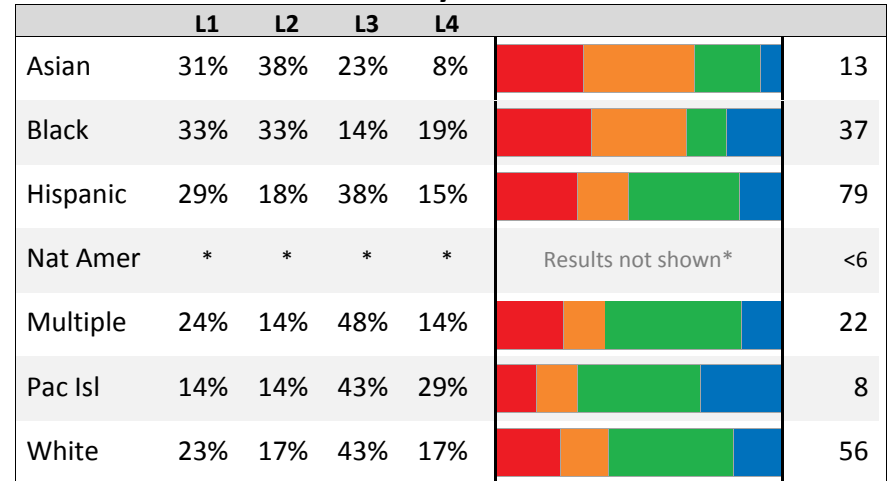
### ELA Overall Achievement by Grade Level

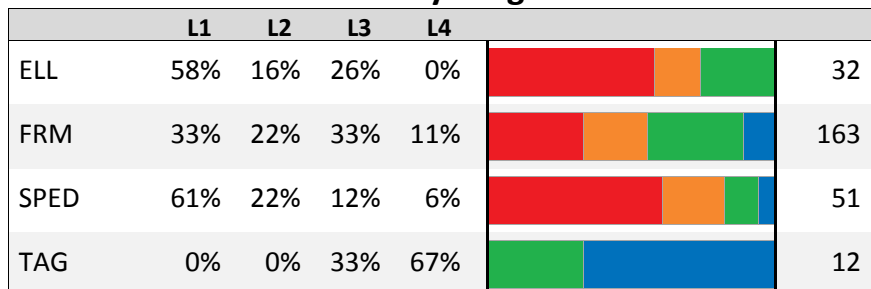
### ELA Overall Achievement by Race

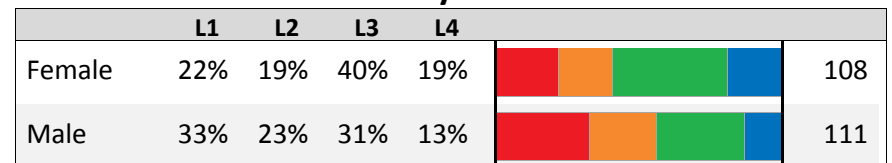

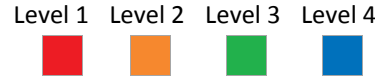

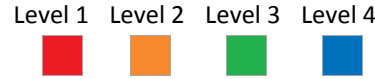
