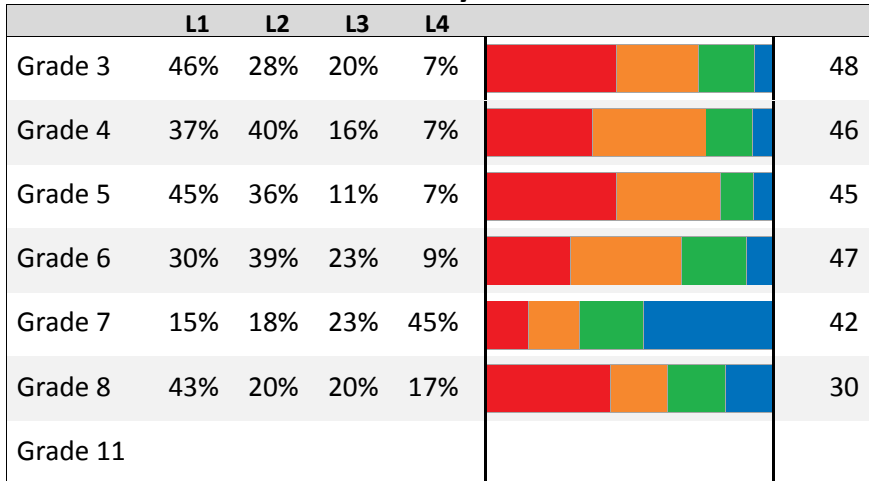

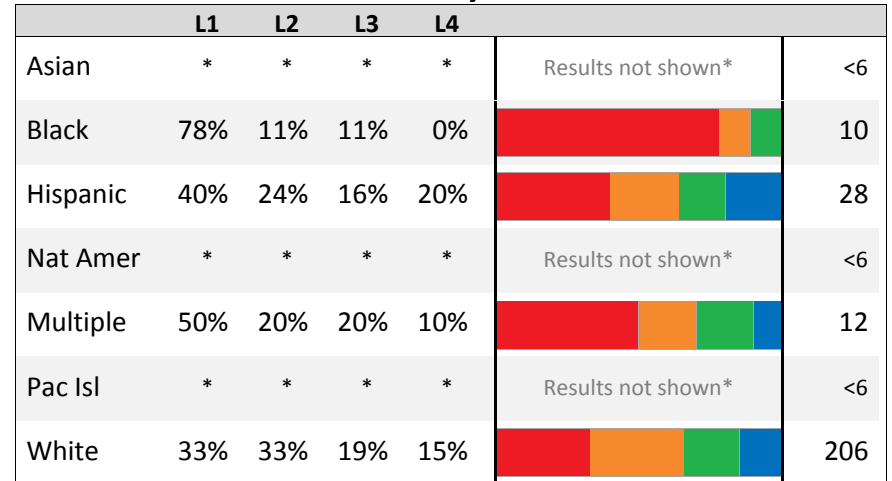

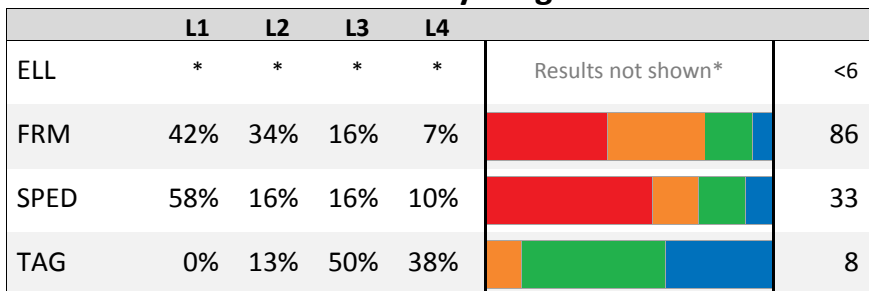
Math Claim 1 Achievement by Grade Level # Tested



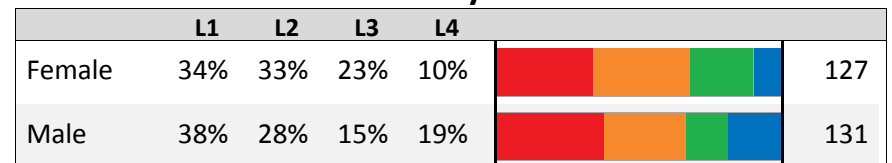
Math Claim 1 Achievement by Race # Tested


