Late Enrollee Ratio:
This is the percentage of students in a given school year who enrolled after October 1 compared to those who enrolled by October 1. The formula is $A / B$, where:
$A=$ the number of students enrolled after October 1
B = the number of students enrolled by October 1

## Stability Index:

This is the percentage of students in a given school year who were enrolled at the same school through most of the school year compared to all students enrolled on October 1st. The formula used is A / B, where:
$A=$ number of students enrolled in the same school through most of the school year
$B=$ the number of students enrolled on October 1
Note: Calculation of stability changed starting in the 2004-05 School Year.
Prior to 2004-05, stability was determined by if a student was enrolled on both October 1 and June 1.
Beginning 2004-05, stability was based on a student being enrolled at the school at least 145 days, which is aproximately $85 \%$ of the school year.
The revised method better accommodates non-standard school calendars, seniors who graduate (and cease attending) in May, and 'short' breaks in educational service.
