Data were extracted from eSIS and HRMS effective January 15, 2013. Student room assignments were matched with teachers, course codes, and period of the day. For K-8 schools and summary average calculations, grade K-5 homeroom classrooms re-weighted for comparability with grade 6-8 course structure.

Title I is a federally funded program seeking the improvement of the academic achievement of the disadvantaged. Portland Public Schools allocates these funds to schools with Free and Reduced Price Meal Eligibility (F&RPM) percent greater than 60% for PK-8 and greater than 75% for high schools.
