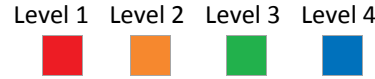

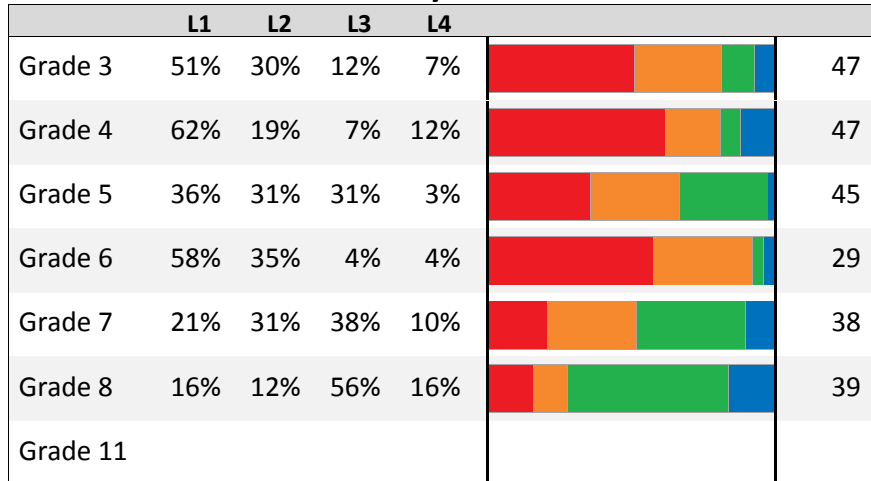

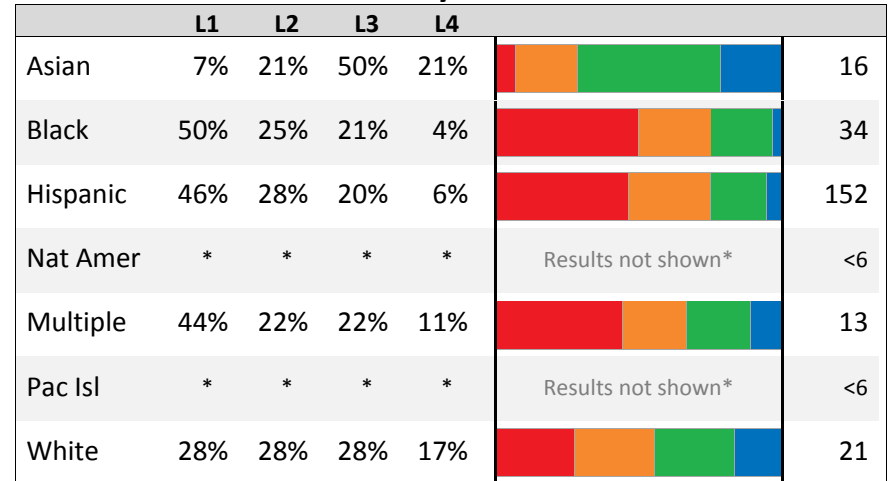

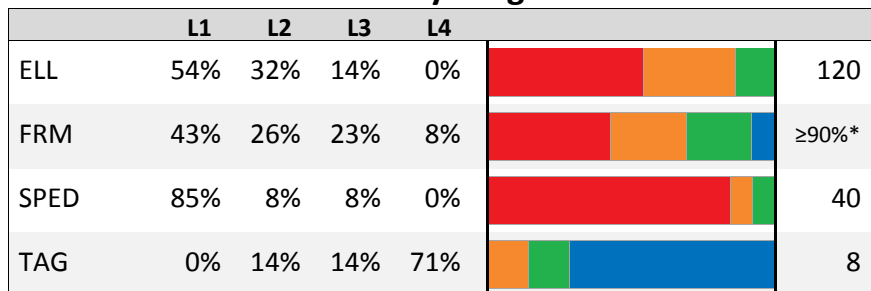
ELA Overall Achievement by Grade Level # Tested



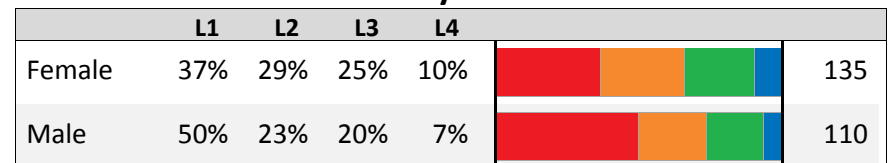
ELA Overall Achievement by Race # Tested

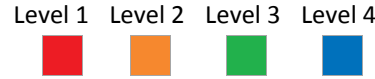

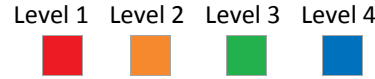
