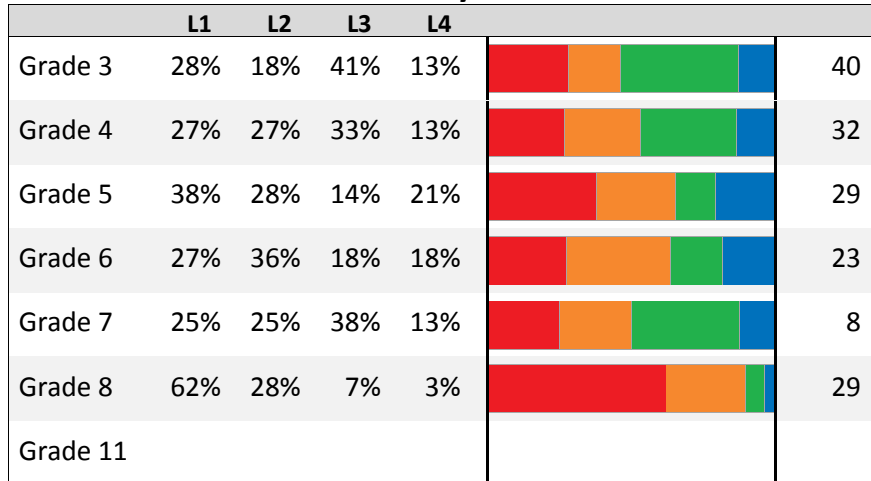

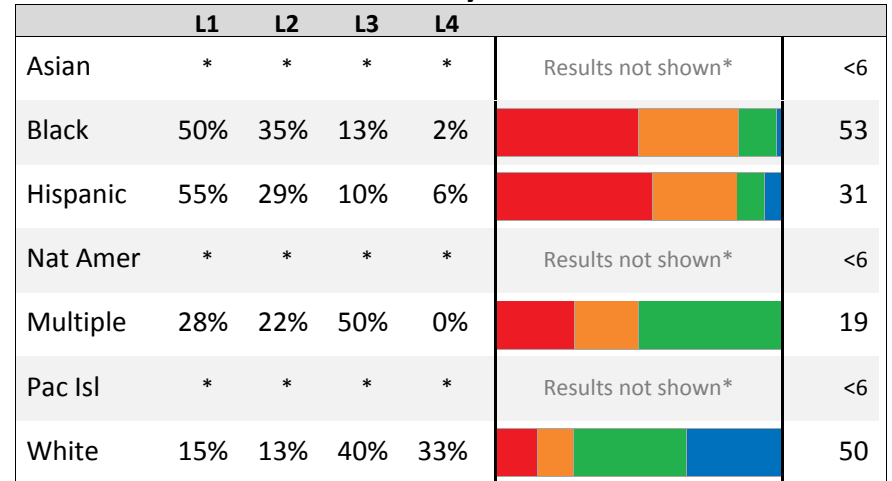
### Math Overall Achievement by Grade Level

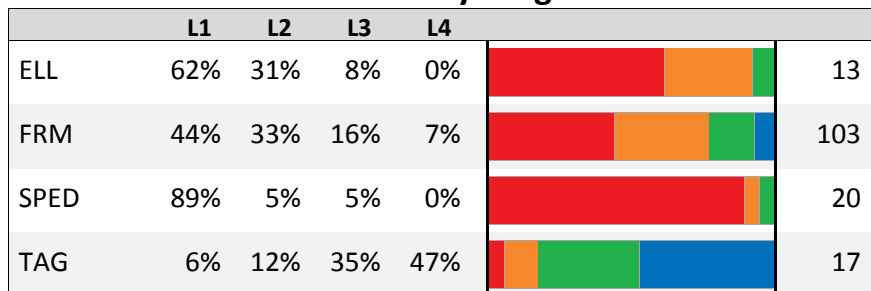
### Math Overall Achievement by Race

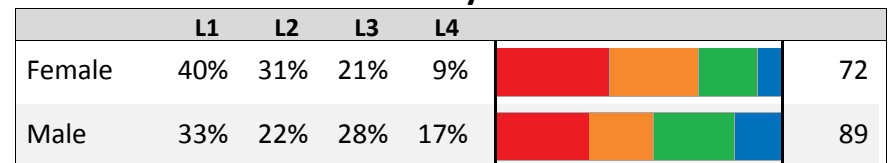
