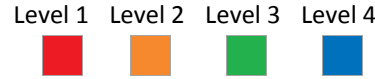

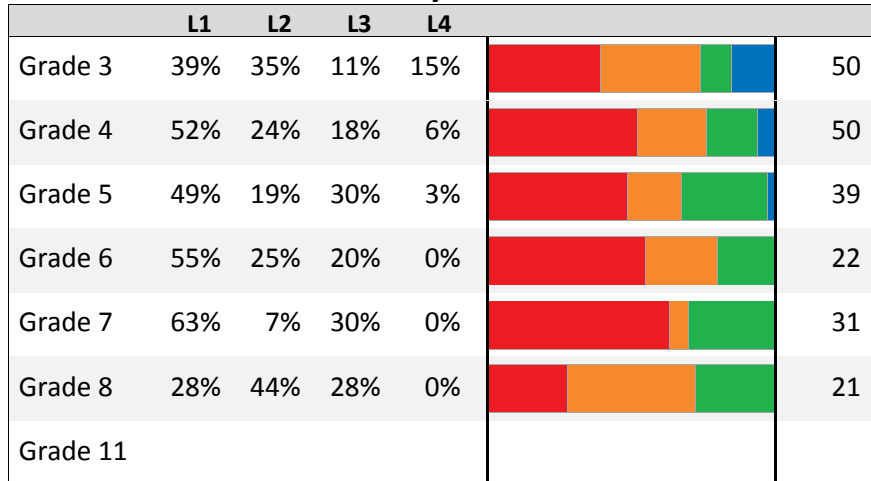

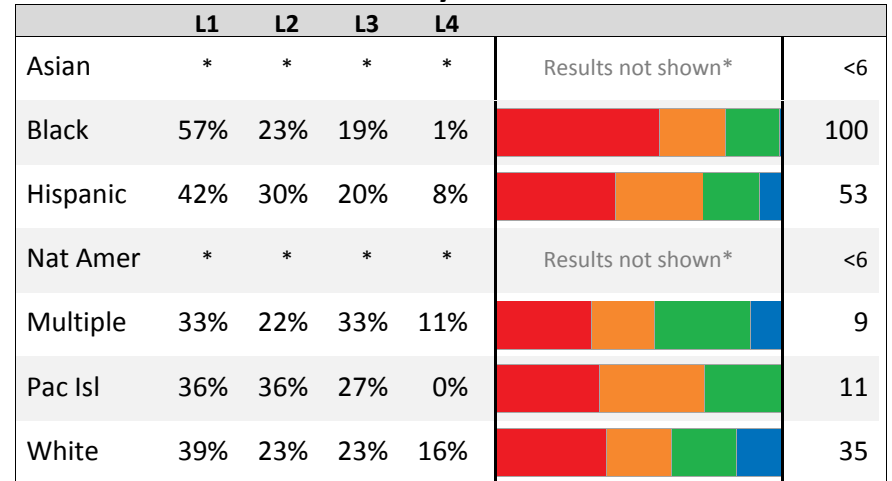
ELA Overall Achievement by Grade Level

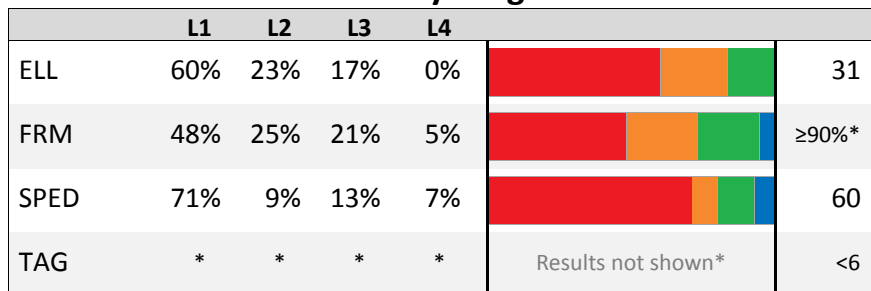
ELA Overall Achievement by Race

Tested



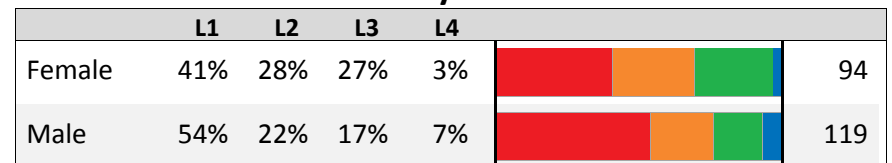
ELA Overall Achievement by Program

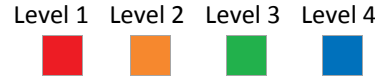
