

2016-17 Substitute Usage

"Substitute Usage (Days)" is the total number of days of substitute usage at each school by individuals in teaching positions, divided by the average number of licensed teachers (and others, such as counselors and media specialists, who receive substitutes when teaching classes) at the school during the year. This is a proxy for the average rate of substitute usage at each school. The weighted average for schools by type is also shown. Notes: Special education and ESL teachers are included in these measures. The following Schools have a permanent substitute on site and use of that substitute may not be reflected in the measures: George, Rosa Parks, César Chávez, MLK Jr, Lent, Rigler, Scott, Vernon, Woodlawn.
