APPENDIX A: 2019-20 OREGON STATEWIDE SUMMATIVE TEST SCHEDULE

Statewide Summative Content Assessments

The test window for the statewide summative content assessments applies both to the online General Assessments and the Extended Assessment versions.

**The PPS window for grades 3-8 begins March 9. Grade 11 can begin testing January 7.

***PPS recommends completing ELPA Summative by March 20 so that results are received prior to June. All EL and recently exited EL students who are enrolled during the full ODE window must take ELPA.

^A Online testing may be offline for scheduled maintenance from 5 p.m. PT on Friday – 7 p.m. PT on Sunday the third weekend each month, as well as from 11:59 p.m. PT on January 3 through 6 a.m. PT on January 7. Click here for a full schedule.

^B Extended versions are available for download at the start of the test window, on 1/7/20. Extended tests requiring Braille or Large Print format must be ordered during the order window: 11/12/19 – 1/10/20. If the data entry deadline is missed, students will be counted as non-participants.

^C The High School grade of accountability is 11th grade. Although not required, 12th graders may also test (for the Extended versions, only 12th graders who have not yet met the achievement standard may retest).

OAKS (Science and Optional Social Science)

OAKS Science is required for grades 5, 8 and 11 and OAKS Social Studies is an optional assessment for grades 5, 8 and 11. OAKS science and social studies windows are:

January 7 – June 5.

SMARTER Balanced Assessment (English Language Arts and Mathematics)

Grade levels 3-8 can begin the Smarter Balanced test once 66% of instructional days have passed. Using the PPS calendar, the following window applies to *grades 3-8* for Smarter Balanced testing in PPS:

March 9 – June 5

Grade 11 can test any time during the full ODE window:
January 7 – June 5

PSAT (Grade 10)

October 16

SAT (Grade 11) (Note that beginning 2019-20 PPS is replacing the Grade 11 ACT test with the SAT school-day test.)

March 4 (makeup date on April 14)

ELPA Summative (English Language Proficiency Assessment)

Schools should plan to test most students between January 7 and March 20. The full ODE window is open until April 12 and schools must test all ELL students enrolled during the full ODE window (Jan 8 – Apr 10) as well as any student exited from ESL since the beginning of the school year.

ELPA Screener

Beginning 2019-20, all schools in Oregon are required to use the ELPA screener to identify students as eligible for ESL services. The screener is used throughout the year. Contact Testing Help if you have questions about the screener.

Kindergarten Assessment

August 28 – September 17 (direct assessment – literacy and math)
September 18 – October 8 (Approaches to Learning)

NAEP

NAEP is a required federal assessment for grades 4, 8 and 11 and schools and grades are randomly selected by NAEP staff. This assessment is managed by NAEP, with some coordination from ODE. If you are selected to participate you should will receive notification from ODE/NAEP. The NAEP testing windows are noted here and NAEP will work directly with schools for specific testing dates within those windows.

Grade 8	October 14 – December 20
Grade 33	March 16 – May 22

Literacy Screening (DIBELS/IDEL and easyCBM)

<i>Fall Window:</i>	September 3 – September 30
<i>Winter Window:</i> ,	January 6 – January 31
<i>Spring Window:</i>	May 4 – May 29
