Dear Families,

Happy Friday! The past week has been busy as teachers and support staff work hard to prepare for our first day next week. On Wednesday AM the entire staff gathered for our first meeting of the year. There was plenty on our agenda, including familiarizing ourselves with a new English Language Arts Curriculum and a new Instructional Framework. In addition, we took some time to celebrate our successes and to begin to identify our hopes for the 2022-2023 School Year. As I have said before, we are incredibly fortunate to have a talented and committed staff.

As a reminder the first day of school for students in 1st - 5th grade is Tuesday, August 30th. The first bell rings at 8:40 AM and students are expected to be in their classrooms, ready to go by the second bell at 8:45 AM.

Kindergarten students will have their "ramp" up during the first four days of school and will begin as a full class on Tuesday, September 6th. Remember, there is no school on Monday, September 5th, in honor of Labor Day.

<u>Arriving at School:</u> My apologies for not being more specific regarding morning arrival and any undue concern or confusion that this created. Here are a few details:

- Any parent/guardian is invited to walk their child(ren) to their classroom during the first days (and if needed weeks or more) of school. This is especially true for our kindergarten students, 1st and 2nd graders, and anyone else who is new to Alameda or who just wants that opportunity. It is our goal and hope that as the year progresses all of our students will feel comfortable entering the building on their own. However, I am fully aware that every child and family is different. We will not be making any hard-fast rules around the timing of this transition. Please do what is right for your family. Know that we are able to support your child if they are having any anxiety or difficulty with saying farewell.
- Please see this document so you know which entrance to use. If you have multiple children
  and you are choosing to come in for drop off, feel free to choose whichever entrance makes
  sense for you.
- If you do come into the building to walk your child to their classroom please do your best to exit the building after the drop off or head to the office to sign-in as a visitor or volunteer.

**Staffing Update:** I am pleased to announce that we have hired Molly Clark to join our counseling team. She will be supporting K, 3rd, and 4th grades. Here is a bit more from Molly: I've been so lucky to be an Alameda parent since 2015, when our oldest son enrolled in kindergarten. My youngest is entering 5th grade and our family has lived in the community since 2009. I have 16 years of counseling experience with time spent at every level: elementary, middle and high school. I am so excited to begin my work at Alameda, building connections with my students and families is so important to me. I'm looking forward to meeting you soon! Molly is finishing up at her work at

her former school and will hopefully be ready to join us by the end of next week. In addition, we are in the final stages of hiring a part-time EA to support 2nd grade and one additional Paraeducator. I should have more details to share next week.
