<u>Phones and Watches:</u> I want to remind families that students should have all phones put away during the school day (and ideally, they should not come to school). In addition, we are having issues with the ever increasing functionality and presence of smart watches. The watches are distracting, pull students away from their community, and have an overall negative impact on their educational experience. We are asking students and families to leave these watches at home, keep them off and in the backpack, or in school-mode.

If you need to communicate something important (that can't wait until the end of the day), you are always welcome to call our office and email your child's teacher. I do understand that some students are walking to/home from school and having a device is for safety purposes. In that case, students should have the device powered off and left in their

backpack during the school day. Our students have plenty of time to use devices outside of school, not to mention the many years and years to come. We thank you for your support.

Bus Arrival: We are going to make a slight shift in how we handle our bus riders in the morning. All students in grades 2-5 will go directly from the bus to their grade level entry areas. Students in K-1 grade will stay on the sidewalk area on NE 27th and will go through either of those doors when the bell rings at 8:40 AM. We will have staff members along 27th providing supervision.

<u>Sensory Space:</u> I want to share some exciting news from the counseling team here at Alameda. We are going to be dedicating an empty classroom for break space, small group work and sensory play. This will be a safe space for children to work with a counselor and also get their personal movement and emotional needs met outside the classroom.
