Dear Families,

Welcome to December! I hope that everyone had a wonderful fall break. For me, it was a great opportunity to visit with family, spend lots of time in the kitchen (which I love), and to celebrate family coming together. The next couple of weeks leading up to our Winter Break will undoubtedly be busy and filled with lots of excitement. Speaking of the holidays, a small gift from PPS will be coming home next week with your child: COVID-19 Test Kits!

To help your holidays be healthy as well as happy, next week our school will provide each student with an iHealth test kit for at-home use. Students and families are encouraged to use these tests if they develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or know they have been exposed to COVID-19. Please note: the FDA granted a shelf-life extension for the iHealth COVID-19 Antigen Rapid Test. Please enter the lot number listed on the end of your test kit box into this tool to check the updated expiration date of your kit.

Speaking of staying healthy, as most of you know, Multnomah County is dealing with a major increase in respiratory illnesses right now, including RSV, Influenza, and COVID. At this time there is no change to the PPS masking policy, however, the county is recommending people wear masks when indoors, including in schools. Here is a link to the MCHD public health advisory. I believe additional communication from PPS will be coming out next week as well. At Alameda, we have seen a pretty significant increase in students being out sick. Thank you to families who are keeping your kids home - we appreciate this as we know it can be challenging. Please remind students about washing hands, covering their coughs, and letting an adult know if they are not feeling well. Welcome back to our nurse Lisa Jones!
