COMMUNITY BUDGET REVIEW COMMITTEE March 29, 2018 Meeting Minutes; 6:30 P.M.; Mazama Conference Room

I. SCHOOL SITE BUDGET ALLOCATION FOLLOW-UP (Ryan Dutcher, Molly Bradley, All; 120 minutes)

We reviewed the school-site budget allocation trends and specifics. We looked at school-byschool staffing numbers and the year-over-year change.

The school site budget allocation ensures a given number of sections by limiting principal discretion, increases the PE program for K-5 students, corrects the inequities of dual immersion enrollment, and corrects the equity allocation by shifting equity dollars to the schools most in need. Overall, staffing in schools is increasing despite decreases in enrollment.

We had questions about the program at the middle school level – are principals required to shift to a 6 of 6 schedule?

CBRC will review the central office budgets at the scheduled **Thursday**, April 12th meeting and respond with comments at the **Tuesday**, April 17th FAO committee meeting.
