Students and families will drive into the turnaround (see map on back side). When it is your turn, your student will get out of the car, pick up their diploma, and then pose for a photo. Your student will get back in the car and you will exit out onto Burr Street (see map).

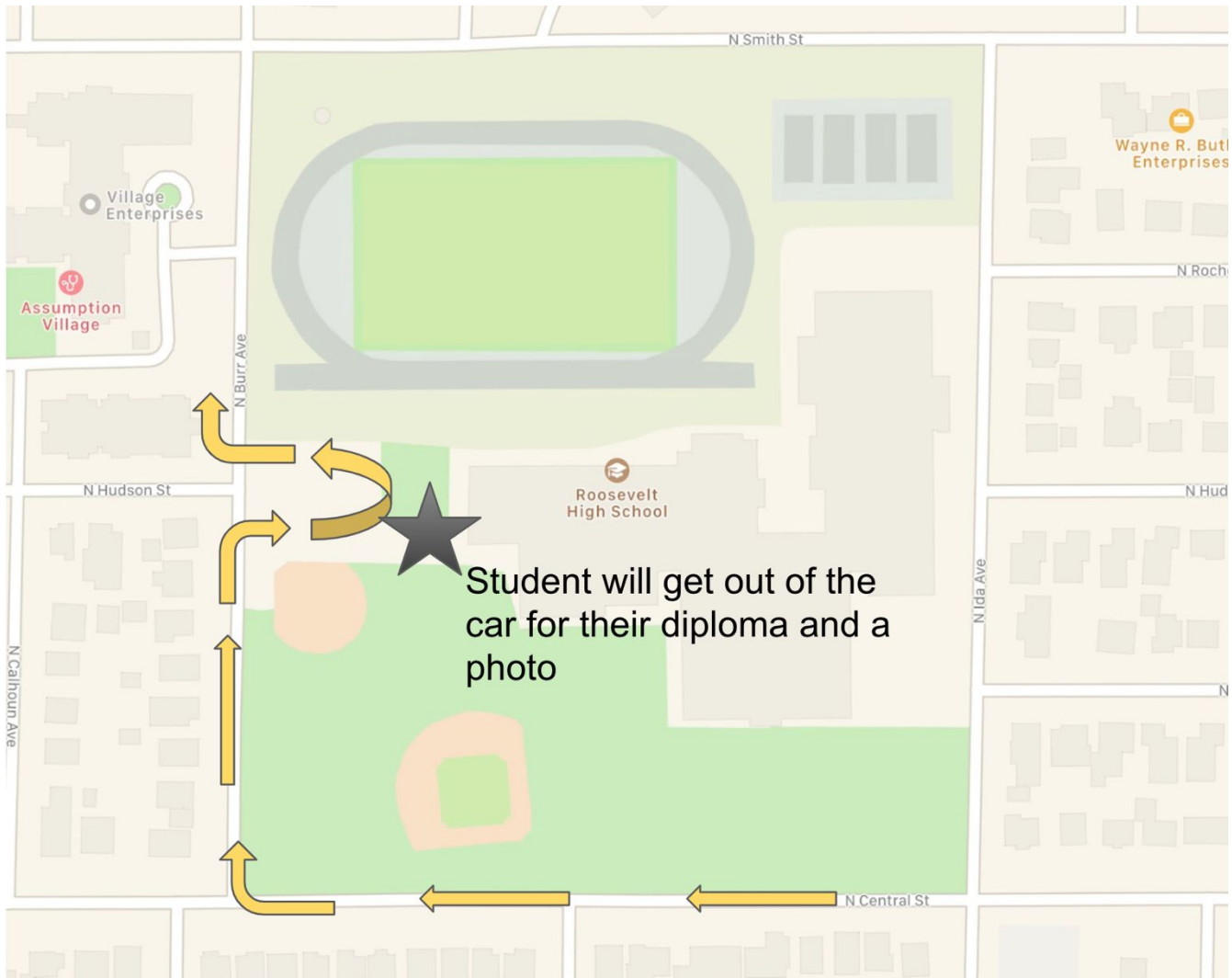
Limit of one car per student

Family members need to stay in the car

We strongly encourage families and students to wear face coverings (except for the picture of course)

If you are walking up to diploma day, you will enter from N Burr St.
You will stand in the designated area until we call you forward.

We ask that you follow the directions to ensure every student can get their diploma and we can keep all of our students and families safe.



Cars can line up along N Burr St (heading North) and N Central St (heading West). Burr will be ONE WAY for the day (you cannot enter Burr from N Smith St).

Families will drive up to the turn-around and give your name to one of the staff members at the entrance to the turn around.

Students will get their stroll from another staff member

When you come up to the turn around, your student will get out of the car, get their diploma, turn to get a picture taken, and get back in the car.

Your family can exit the turnaround and turn right onto Burr.

This is not a graduation ceremony. There will not be any speeches or other celebrations on this day. There will be a virtual graduation later in June, and we will find a way to celebrate the class of 2020 together when it is safe to do so.

If you cannot make it - we will mail you your diploma after the Diploma Day event
