Happy New Year! Welcome to 2020! It has been great first week back. Vacations and breaks are so valuable for rejuvenation and time to spend with our family and friends. A winter wedding brought more than the usual number of relatives to town, which while making life busy, filled my bucket. I hope you all had the time to spend with families and friends enjoying each other's company and celebrating traditions together.

Since returning from Winter Break, we haven't seemed to miss a beat. Students are busy continuing important learning in non-fiction reading and writing, our second graders are preparing for their upcoming concert (January 28th), and our building is getting fitted for increased safety features. If you see workers in orange sweatshirts, those are the electricians installing speakers and wiring the school for upgraded security features, including Emergency Notifications abilities in the school common areas, such as the gym, cafeteria, and hallways. They will also be installing an electronic door lock/video intercom system on the front door. When complete, visitors will need to "buzz the office" to enter the building. A large screen will allow us to see who is at the door. All doors, including the front door, will remain locked during school hours. Once in, visitors are still expected to come to the office to sign in the Raptor system for visitors and volunteers. This process will take a few weeks to complete. We will keep you posted as to when the system will begin here at Llewellyn.

Teacher Aubrey has accepted a new position as the Media Specialist at Ainsworth Elementary and will begin in that placement next week. She was not expecting to make a change mid-year, but the fact that Mr. Chou is able to step into the classroom full-time gave here the reassurance she needed to pursue this opportunity. After fifteen years in the classroom, and with a changing family, Llewellyn is excited for this opportunity for Teacher Aubrey. She has been a valuable member of our staff and she will be missed!

While the Nutrition Services department has processed thousands of applications for free/reduced price meal benefits for families this fall and many others were directly certified (eligible) because they received SNAP benefits, we are finding that families who were eligible last year may not have reapplied this school year. On October 10, all families who were eligible last school year (2018-19) and did not reapply this school year, switched from free/reduced status to paid status. It is not too late! You can still apply at any time. If a family's financial situation has changed midyear, they can still apply throughout the school year.
