I hope this has been a good week for you and your child! This week I have been finding joy in visiting classrooms. It is so gratifying to see our students interacting with each other and with their teacher, laughing, sharing their work, and just being kids! With all the stress we are all feeling these days for a myriad of reasons, we all need to have a place to go or something to do that fills our heart and renews our reason for doing what we do. Seeing your children in their classrooms does this for me. Here are a few highlights from some of my classroom visits:

In music class students were studying Mariachi music. They discussed and participated in a Seesaw activity that allowed them to explore Mariachi Instruments. Students were excited by the large bass guitar, the Guitarrón, and shared that the music made them feel happy. You could see students moving to the music and almost get up to dance.

In 2nd grade, students were working on adding "juicy words" to their stories and putting to bed words such as "said." I was incredibly impressed by the word choice students were making such as "petite" and "tiny as a loaf of bread." In this particular writing group, students couldn't wait to share their writing. Their words really painted a picture in my mind of their experience.

In Kindergarten, students were talking about friendship and were able to share about the many different kinds of friendship they have.

In 1st grade, students were applying what they know about the Zones of Regulation to the characters in a story read aloud by their teacher. They could state the zone then use evidence from the story as to why they thought one of the characters felt a certain way.

These are only a few examples, but it shows to me that even during Distance Learning our students can do amazing things. While I miss being with students in person, I love being a part of their school experience online. Thank you parents and teachers for all you do to keep our students engaged, focused on building relationships, and continuously learning!
