A Message from Principal Pam:

On Tuesday, February 4th, our Superintendent shared with administration community feedback and goals for next year around staffing. I was able to share this with some of you at our most recent PTA meeting later that evening. In case you missed it, here is a bit of what I shared.

Information gathered from the community, staff, and students was used to shape the plan that will be unveiled in greater detail soon by Guadalupe Guerrero, our superintendent over the next three years. At the heart of the plan are our students. In order to create the conditions that students need to succeed in becoming "a compassionate critical thinker, able to collaborate and solve problems, and be prepared to lead a more socially just world" we need increased academic supports and targeted interventions for our most vulnerable and historically underserved students; increased social emotional, mental and behavioral health supports across the district; culturally-specific student and family supports and expanded community partnerships; more optimal student-teacher ratios and class sizes; more equitable access to arts education; and curriculum materials and training for educators.

While this list may not seem specific to Llewellyn in some ways, I am excited to see that the system shifts coming our way align with what many of us want for our school around social emotional learning, an inclusive school culture, smaller class sizes, and engaging curriculum that allows our students and teachers to thrive. I hope to share with you soon how these goals and funding from the Student Success Act will help shape our staff for next year here at Llewellyn. What is the first thing that comes to your mind when you hear the phrase "successful schools?" We believe that successful schools are safe, healthy and welcoming learning spaces that are inclusive for all students. But we want to hear your thoughts.

In 2019-20, Portland Public Schools is again partnering with Panorama Education to gather information students and families that will help us improve student experiences across the district. We will survey students in grades 4, 5, 7-10 on their experiences in their classrooms and schools, and families about their perception of the school their child attends.

The survey will cover topics on sense of belonging, school safety, school climate, barriers to family engagement, as well as how students are thinking and feeling about diversity, equity, and inclusion in school.

The current launch date is set for January 27th, the student window is scheduled to be open until February 14th and the family survey until February 28th. Stay tuned for further information!
