Dear Families,

As we make plans to end the school year, my heart is full for our students, but especially so for our 5th graders who will be leaving us for middle school. We can all agree that this group has missed out on so many things: the 5th Grade Play, their music performance, OMSI Overnight Camp, and a traditional promotion ceremony. However, one thing this group of students has gained is the ability to be **resilient** and to face the unexpected with **courage**. Our personal stories emerge from our life experiences, both good and bad, and are part of what shapes who we are. While we are not sure how this pandemic will continue to affect us, one thing is certain, when our students are asked to write personal narrative essays next year, they will not be able to say they have nothing to write about.

To honor our 5th Graders and all our students for their courage, effort, and ability to be SAFE, RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, and to BUILD COMMUNITY even during a pandemic, we will be holding a **Drive-Thru Promotion** (or needed option for those who do not use cars) for our 5th graders and one final **Staff Parade** through the school neighborhood. Details for the promotion and Parade will be shared very soon. As a heads up, Promotion will be held at 2:00 pm on Wednesday, June 9th and the Staff Parade will begin that same day at 4:00 pm. The parade will follow the same route as before. We would love your participation cheering on our 5th graders and celebrating our community during the Neighborhood parade, but want to remind everyone that we must ensure the safety of everyone by following CDC Safety Guidelines.

On everyone's mind these days is whether students will return to Llewellyn to attend school in person, will we participate in Distance Learning once again (with improvements), or will another option be used next fall? These are huge questions that at this time we are not able to answer. All decisions will be made following guidance by the CDC, the Oregon Department of Education, Governor Kate Brown, and PPS leaders.

As we wait for instructions, staff at Llewellyn have been busy making plans for next year, creating next year's class lists, and preparing for a summer of professional development.
