Unit 5 – "Growth and Development, and Violence Prevention" Unit 5 Health for grades K-5 will begin approximately on May 17, 2021 and will review growth and development education and child sexual abuse prevention curriculum, in alignment with <u>Oregon Health Standards</u>, state law and <u>district requirements</u>.
