### 5th Grade Promotion Celebration:

As the year winds down, we are preparing to send off another group of AMAZING 5th graders. This group has been through so much during their final one and one-half years at Llewellyn and we couldn't be prouder of their ability to persevere through the many challenges and changes. We are confident they are ready for middle school. <u>Our plan is to celebrate our 5th graders with a parade!</u> This time, instead of only a car parade, students and their families will have the option to "WALK" or "Drive." <u>The event will take place on Wednesday</u>, June 9th and will begin at 9:45 AM and end at about 12:00. ### From PPS: Digital Tools/Digital Toolkit Summer Access

Students will have access to most <u>PPS Digital Toolkit</u> applications during the summer. Students who enroll in summer school may notice changes in some applications once summer school begins. Most PPS Digital Toolkit applications will remain active until the end of July. Applications may be temporarily unavailable at the beginning of August as PPS shifts to the 2021-2022 school year. PPS will be moving from Clever to using <u>My.PPS</u> (my.pps.net) as a district-wide portal. Students using QR Clever badges to log in to Chromebooks will no longer be able to use their Clever badge once the change to My.PPS is complete. Students will need their PPS username and password to log in to their chromebooks until they are issued a new Quickcard (QR code) at the start of school.

Please note that during the summer months, teachers are not active inside the digital tools and applications. Parents should be aware of what students are doing online. Parents may find the <u>Securly</u> application and <u>digital and civic literacy</u> resources helpful.

#### **KIDS IN CRISIS**

The pandemic has had an alarming impact on the mental health of children, with a 31% increase in mentalhealth-related emergency room visits in 2020. Get help from a professional counselor when a child's behavioral issues or emotional difficulties last more than a few weeks and/or are causing problems at school, at home, or with friends.
