

Individual teachers may have additional requests in the fall.

- 4 2-pocket folders, one of each color: red, yellow, blue, green (**plastic preferred**)
- 3 college ruled spiral notebooks (unless student needs wider lines then buy wide ruled paper)
- 2 college ruled composition notebooks (unless student needs wider lines then buy wide ruled paper)
- 2 extra fine point black Sharpies (any brand for outlining or making print stand out)
- 2 blue or black ball point pens (gel pens are fine)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 box of #2 pencils, sharpened (Crouser*) **OR** 2 mechanical pencils .7mm with lead refills (Rozell)
*students may have either kind for Crouser
- 1 eraser (white or square gum colored art eraser preferred)
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 box of 10 Crayola brand fine tip markers
- 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils, sharpened
- 1 package of college ruled loose leaf paper
- 1 personal hand held pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil pouch that can hold 4 pencils, ball point pens, personal pencil sharpener, and eraser
- 1 pencil box that can hold colored pencils and fine tip markers (will be stored in lockers)
- adult sized scissors
- water bottle for daily use in class

Optional Supplies:

- 1 ruler (inches and centimeters, a one foot ruler is best to fit in a desk)
- 1 pack of watercolor paper
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 purple folder as an extra for homework if Llewellyn folder wears out
- \$10-\$20 donation for classroom art supplies

GYM SHOES

Appropriate athletic shoes should be worn on PE day in both the gym and outside. Rubber soled shoes with closed toes that close with Velcro or shoe laces are appropriate. Please no boots, rain boots, sandals, shoes that slip off easily, or shoes with slick soles. They are not safe for wear during PE. Shorts are encouraged under dresses.

Llewellyn students may purchase breakfast at **7:40 am** each morning. Breakfast cost is **\$1.50** for students, or **free** for students who qualify for free/reduced lunches. Lunch cost is **\$2.90** or **free** and milk is **.50** cents.
