Kindergarten Supply List 2020-2021

A full size backpack works best for transporting personal items and folders between home and school. Storage space is limited, so we may ask for replenishment of supplies later in the year. Occasionally, we may send a note home asking for miscellaneous materials to use when doing special units.

Most items are shared so no names are needed on most supplies

12 #2 pencils **Ticonderoga** (sharpened) 12 washable **ELMER'S** glue sticks

1 box **CRAYOLA** colored pencils 12 count 1 composition book (**one subject, wide ruled, black**)

1 white 1 inch 3-ring binder 2 wide ruled spiral notebooks (**one subject, solid color**)

10 **BLACK** fine point Sharpies water bottle (please label with name)

1 set **CRAYOLA** watercolors 1 pack baby wipes

2 packs of **CRAYOLA** Crayons 24 count 2 containers disinfecting wipes

1 pack thick markers **CRAYOLA** 10 count 1 box of Kleenex tissues

1 pack thin markers CRAYOLA 10 count

10 BLACK thin fine tip dry erase markers (EXPO brand, not chisel)

Optional Supplies:

1 pack quality watercolor paper masking tape hand sanitizer (any size with a pump top)

<u>Please send a complete change of clothes in a labeled plastic bag in your child's backpack the first week of school – it will be stored in their locker in case of emergencies. Students are encouraged, but not required, to keep an extra pair of shoes in the locker for PE days, muddy accidents and yellow puddles.</u>

GYM SHOES

Appropriate athletic shoes should be worn on PE day in both the gym and outside. Rubber soled shoes with closed toes that close with Velcro or shoe laces are appropriate. Please no boots, rain boots, sandals, shoes that slip off easily, or shoes with slick soles. They are not safe for wear during PE. Shorts are encouraged under dresses.

SCHOOL LUNCH PRICES

Llewellyn students may purchase breakfast at **7:40 am** each morning. Breakfast cost is **\$1.50** for students, or **free** for students who qualify for free/reduced lunches. Lunch cost is **\$2.90** or free/reduced and milk is **.50** cents. Federal lunch applications are available online at www.pps.k12.or.us/departments/nutrition/index.htm or may be picked up at the school office. A new application must be completed every year.

Money can be put in the student's account and each day a meal is purchased, the student scans their card and the price is deducted from their account.
