Career Related Learning Experience (CRLE) Reflection

After attending your career event, you must document your experience. Reflections are required to show the district that you are exposed to career events. You have two options for documenting the experience. Show your learning experience by providing one of the following:

Option #1: You can upload a creative project in place of the written CRLE Form.

- Google slide, Digital presentation, or Recorded interview

Please include journals, pictures, videos, reports, brochures, worksheets, etc. Share your slides with your Career Coordinator, Ms. Spencer, by attaching your presentation to the link provided. Make sure the permission is "Anyone with this link can view"

My Plan Project

The My Plan Project is a formal reflection of a student's high school experiences related to college and career, community, and future plans and goals. It is to be completed in Senior English/Inquiry and approved by the teacher. Once approved by the teacher, students should upload their essays using the link below.

In your My Plan Project, you will need to address the following four areas*:

1. Explain your **future life aspirations and your plans to put them into motion**. Clearly articulate both short and long term goals and describe the interests, skills, and experiences that helped you develop your post-high school life plan.
2. Illustrate **how you have contributed to your local community and/or to the great global community**. This could relate to family, school, organizations, activism, belief systems, etc. Provide specific examples and include what you learned from these experiences. How did these experiences help to inform your vision for your life in the future?
3. Describe a **personal accomplishment or challenge you have overcome**. What were the barriers you encountered and what strengths and skills did you find within yourself to succeed? Reflect on how this experience will serve you in your future.
4. Describe an **important change or transition that has occurred in your life so far**. How did you navigate this and what have you learned about yourself?
