



PPS SCHOOL BUILDING IMPROVEMENT BOND

Cleveland High School

Cleveland High School is one of seven Portland Public Schools receiving facility improvements during the summer of 2016 as PPS launches into the fourth summer of its 8-year \$482 million School Building Improvement Bond. Cleveland High School will receive a new seismically strengthened roof and some accessibility improvements.

Cleveland High School - Construction Details

- Roof level seismic improvements with re-roofing that will include new insulation, some rooftop mechanical, roofing materials, roof ladders and new steel trusses in the gym penthouse.
- Removal of the brick chimney.
- Accessibility improvements include new drinking fountains, handrails, accessible ramps, door hardware and two new restrooms.

Stay Informed-What you need to know

- The school will be closed all summer, including all offices.
- Cleveland High School summer programs and office staff will be relocated to other sites.
- Construction fencing will surround the school including the asphalt walkways and parking areas.
- The track and sports fields on 32nd will remain open..
- There will be increased construction traffic in and around school grounds.
- There may be some street closures please check the website for any updates.
- Work may occur in the evenings and on weekends.
- School registration will take place at Cleveland High School.

Project timeline



Construction will begin immediately following the end of school in June. The project team will start and finish the work this summer unless otherwise noted. The work is scheduled during the summer to minimize the impact on schools and students.
